Tribal Consultation Action Items

Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP)

Care Management Organization (CMO) Expansion Population - Rachel

- DHCFP presented an overview of the Health Care Guidance Program (HCGP).
 - Tribal Governments requested the number of American Indian and Alaska Native enrolled.

National Governor's Association (NGA) Children's Behavioral Health Transformation Project – Jenni

- Nevada has been selected to work on the NGA project regarding the growing behavioral health crisis. The goal is to screen all children entering into the 7th grade. If they are in crisis, they receive services. If they are a rising risk, they receive a package and access to services. If they are a watch and wait, they will receive a second assessment.
 - Tribal Governments requested a cultural review for children who are not captured in school.
 - DHCFP will be sending an email to all IHP clinics requesting information on assessment tools used and staff conducting assessments.

Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) – Shannon

- Three policy workshops have been completed. The chapter has completed the clearance process and the anticipated effective date is January 1, 2016. Provider enrollment training has been completed in the north and south. HPES will provide continued training.

Legislative Summary – Laurie

- Overview of the legislative session provided to include ABA, rate increases, and telehealth.
 - Tribal Governments had positive feedback about ABA, Rate increase, and telehealth indicating all will assist with access to care, reduce expenditures of Purchase and Referred Care dollars, and increase the specialty care providers that the IHP can bring into the clinics.
 - Tribal Governments requested billing training throughout the state in regard to correctly billing the five encounters and how they relate to each MSM Chapter. DHCFP provided the link to the HP training page at:

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Division of Welfare and Supportive Services – Naomi Lewis

- DWSS presented an update on the call center.
 - The Tribal Government requested to have the ability to determine Medicaid eligibility and to be included in Presumptive Eligibility.
 - Tribal Governments requested an updated paper application that coincides with the electronic application. DWSS responded they are waiting on CMS approval.
 - Tribal Governments have requested a meeting to further discuss DWSS eligibility staff within the IHP clinics, or contracts with DWSS for IHP staff to determine eligibility.

State Innovative Model (SIM) – Jan

- Provided an overview of the SIM grant.
 - Tribal Governments indicated they would be happy to participate and provide input. DHCFP has connected the Rates Unit with contact information for the Tribes and IHS.

Silver State Health Insurance Exchange – Matt Robinson

- Addendum letters have been sent out and they are a requirement for the FQHC's when they sign up with the SSHIX.
 - Tribal Governments requested a copy of the letter.
- The open enrollment will be starting soon. They have recruited for the assistance in mailers, people to be out in the community knocking on doors, etc. They should be starting in approximately one month.
 - Tribal Governments requested coordination of a meeting between HP, Tribal Governments, Insurance Commission, and the SSHIX for better communication of issues.

Department of Health and Human Services – Julia

- DHHS introduced the new Tribal Liaison.
 - Tribal Governments welcomed.
