Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

With the recent approval of Senate Bill 156 during the 2021 Legislative Session, DHCFP is proposing revisions to the Nevada Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 400 – Mental Health and Alcohol and Substance Abuse Services and the Medicaid State Plan Attachment (SPA) 4.19-B pages 4a & 4b to ensure that crisis stabilization services provided at hospitals with a crisis stabilization center endorsement are covered and reimbursable services under Nevada Medicaid. The goal of this legislation is to add a place to go as a critical element of the crisis continuum of care to support an array of crisis services critical in caring for individuals experiencing a behavioral health crisis. New policy includes scope of services for crisis stabilization centers, primary objective, requirements, best practices, provider responsibilities, and admission criteria. Crisis stabilization centers best patient outcomes may include immediate care and positive behavioral health crisis response. SPA language will address the rate methodology utilized for a daily rate of service. Providers will be reimbursed a daily default rate and after an individual and complete fiscal year of providing services, providers will be allowed to complete a cost report, of which an individual rate will be calculated.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Government.
