Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

DHCFP is proposing revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 2500 – Case Management and MSM Chapter 2700 – Certified Community Behavioral Health Centers (CCBHC) to ensure that duplication of services is not occurring for a single Medicaid recipient who is enrolled in a Medicaid Managed Care Organization (MCO) and receiving case management services through a CCBHC. Language in MSM 2500 and MSM 2700 is being proposed to clarify the role of the Lead Case Manager. When a recipient is eligible for Medicaid through an MCO, it is the responsibility of the Lead Case Manager to ensure that the identified MCO is notified of the recipient's participation in Targeted Case Management (TCM), in addition to coordinating all care with the MCO.

There is currently no anticipated fiscal impact to Tribal Governments.
