## PUBLIC NOTICE TO SOLICIT COMMENT ON INTENT TO SUBMIT A STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO AMEND REIMBURSEMENT RATES FOR CERTAIN PROVIDERS WHO RENDER APPLIED BEHAVIOR ANALYSIS SERVICES

**Purpose**: The purpose of this notice is to provide the public with information and to collect public feedback regarding the state's intent to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) for federal approval of reimbursement rate changes for certain providers of Applied Behavior Analysis services. **Overview:** During the 2021 Legislative Session, Senate Bill 96 was signed into law and is now codified under Nevada Revised Statutes 422.27497. Among other requirements, NRS 422.27497 directed DHCFP to determine the reimbursement rates paid by other states' Medicaid programs for Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) services rendered by Board Certified Behavior Analysts (BCBAs), Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analysts (BCBAs), and Registered Behavior Technicians (RBTs). Reimbursement rates paid to these providers by the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy are required to be set at a rate commensurate with the reimbursement rates paid by other states' Medicaid programs. This rate alignment is effective beginning July 1, 2023, and updated on a biennial basis.

Based on DHCFP's research to date, aligning reimbursement rates as described above would result in rate increases for some procedures/specialties, but would also result in decreases to some reimbursement rates. During the 2023 Legislative Session, DHCFP included a requested authorization within the DHCFP budget to implement these rate changes. Feedback from legislators and the public indicated concern with potentially reducing some reimbursement rates. As such, the legislative body indicated that Nevada Medicaid should only align reimbursement rates with other states in the event the change would result in an *increase* to the current rates.

**Methodology:** The Rate Analysis and Development Unit has been researching other states' reimbursement rates for ABA services rendered by BCBAs, BCaBAs, and RBTs using fee schedule information found on each state's website. The Division makes every effort to ensure the parameters of services provided in other states are equitable to the service provided in Nevada prior to including the reimbursement rate in the comparison.

DHCFP then calculates the median reimbursement rate among other states for each procedure code billable by each specialty indicated in the statute. If the median reimbursement rate paid by other states exceeds the current rate paid by Nevada Medicaid for the same procedure and specialty, the reimbursement rate will be increased to align with the median rate paid by other states. In the event aligning the reimbursement rate paid by Nevada Medicaid with the median rate would result in a decrease to the rate, no change will be made to the reimbursement for that procedure and specialty. Of the 21 reimbursement rates analyzed, 13 reimbursement rates are expected to increase while 8 reimbursement rates will remain unchanged. The state is seeking an effective date of July 1, 2023, for these rate increases. Rate changes are anticipated to be enacted July 1 of each odd-numbered year.

**Expected Expenditures:** The state anticipates an increase to annual aggregate expenditures as follows to implement the rate increases as described above:
