PUBLIC NOTICE TO SOLICIT COMMENT ON THE INTENT TO SUBMIT A STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO REIMBURSE FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH CENTERS (FQHC) AND RURAL HEALTH CLINICS (RHC) FOR LONG-ACTING REVERSIBLE **CONTRACEPTIVES (LARCs) OUTSIDE OF THEIR MEDICAL ENCOUNTER RATES**

Purpose:

The purpose of this notice is to provide the public with information and to collect public feedback regarding the state's intent to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) for federal approval to implement changes to the reimbursement methodology for Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) and Rural Health Clinics (RHCs) for Long-Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARCs). The proposed State Plan Amendment would allow FQHCs/RHCs to be reimbursed separately for Long-Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARC), outside of their established medical encounter rates. FQHC/RHCs would be reimbursed separately for both the device and the insertion/removal procedure, in addition to their established medical encounter rates. These changes will be effective January 1, 2024.

Overview: Currently, FQHC/RHCs are not reimbursed separately for these services, and their established medical encounter rates do not adequately cover the costs associated with LARCs. In order to enhance access to these types of contraceptives, the Division is proposing an amendment to allow FQHC/RHCs to be reimbursed for LARC devices and insertion/removal costs outside of their established medical encounter rates.

The Division is keenly interested in ensuring that Medicaid participants have access to effective reproductive health care and ensuring that our providers are reimbursed adequately for providing these vital services will go a long way in creating that access.

Methodology: FQHCs and RHCs will continue to be reimbursed their established medical encounter rates. However, upon implementation of this State Plan Amendment, FQHC/RHCs may submit additional claims to be reimbursed separately for LARC devices and insertion or removal, which will be paid in accordance with the reimbursement methodologies outlined in State Plan Attachment 4.19-B.

Expected Expenditures: The State is working to determine any potential financial impacts from the proposed changes. Any success in preventing unplanned pregnancies can only result in lowering health care costs for both the mother and the child and potentially reduce risks to mothers if pregnancies occur too close together.
