Purpose:

The purpose of this notice is to provide the public with information and to collect public feedback regarding the state's intent to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) for federal approval of a new reimbursement methodology for Rural Emergency Hospitals. The new methodology will be effective January 1, 2024.

Overview: Effective January 1, 2023, a final rule was enacted by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) establishing rural emergency hospitals as a new Medicare provider type. Per the rule, rural emergency hospitals (REHs) are authorized to provide emergency department services, observation care, and additional outpatient medical and health services so long as the annual per patient length of stay does not exceed 24 hours. During the 2023 Legislative Session, Assembly Bill (AB) 277 was passed and signed into law. AB 277 allowed rural emergency hospitals to become licensed in Nevada. Additionally, AB 277 also directed the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy to implement a State Plan Amendment to "provide increased rates of reimbursement under the State Plan for rural emergency hospital services provided by a rural emergency hospital."

Methodology: The Division intends to reimburse rural emergency hospitals services at an amount equal to a 5 percent increase over the existing reimbursement rates for outpatient hospital services (provider type 12).

Expected Expenditures: The state anticipates an increase to annual medical aggregate expenditures to the Division's budget as follows to implement the new reimbursement methodology addressed above:
