## PUBLIC NOTICE TO SOLICIT COMMENT ON INTENT TO SUBMIT A STATE PLAN AMENDMENT TO UNBUNDLE LONG-ACTING REVERSIBLE CONTRACEPTIVES FROM MATERNITY PER DIEM RATES FOR GENERAL ACUTE HOSPITALS

#### Purpose:

The purpose of this notice is to provide the public with information and to collect public feedback regarding the state's intent to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) for federal approval to impose changes to the reimbursement methodology for maternity services provided by general acute hospitals (Provider Type 11). The proposed State Plan Amendment would allow hospitals to be reimbursed separately for Long-Acting Reversible Contraceptives (LARC). Hospitals would be reimbursed separately for both the device and the insertion/removal procedure, in addition to the maternity per diem rate currently reimbursed. These changes will be effective January 1, 2024.

**Overview:** Currently, general acute hospitals are reimbursed for inpatient maternity services at a per diem rate of \$1,197. This reimbursement rate covers all services rendered throughout the course of the inpatient day. However, the cost of LARC devices may approach or exceed the current maternity per diem payment. In order to enhance access to contraceptives, the Division is proposing an amendment to allow hospitals to be reimbursed for LARC devices and insertion/removal separately, in addition to the maternity per diem payment.

During the 2023 Nevada Legislative Session, Senate Bill (SB) 280 was passed and signed into law. SB 280 requires hospitals "to provide for the insertion or injection on certain long-acting reversible contraception if requested by a patient giving birth at a hospital." Although Medicaid is already in compliance with this bill, the current reimbursement rates for maternity services may create barriers to patients accessing these services.

**Methodology:** General acute hospitals will continue to be reimbursed \$1,197 per day for maternity services. However, upon implementation of this State Plan Amendment, general acute hospitals may submit additional claims to be reimbursed separately for LARC devices and insertion/removal, which will be paid in accordance with the reimbursement methodologies outlined in State Plan Attachment 4.19-B.

**Expected Expenditures:** The State is working to determine any potential financial impacts from the proposed changes.
