## PUBLIC NOTICE TO SOLICIT COMMENTS ON AMENDMENTS TO THE ALTERNATIVE BENEFIT PLAN OF STATE PLAN FOR MEDICAID SERVICES

2. This public notice is to add the following information that was inadvertently omitted from the previous Public Hearing Notice published on February 4, 2021. Additionally, the items addressed in the State Plan Amendment (SPA NV 21-0004) were provided for Tribal Consultation/Notification on January 22, 2021.

In accordance with 42 CFR §440.386, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy is proposing an amendment to the Alternative Benefits Plan to the State Plan for Medicaid Services that would add Medication-Assisted Treatment (MAT) as required by Section 1006(b) of the Substance Use-Disorder Prevention that Promotes Opioid Recovery and Treatment (SUPPORT) for Patients and Communities Act, HR 6, and, Section 1905(a)(29) of the Social Security Act. Section 1006(b) of the SUPPORT Act requires states to begin implementing MAT as a mandatory Medicaid state plan benefit for categorically needy populations for the 5-year period beginning October 1, 2020. This ABP update will combine already required covered medications and services used in MAT for Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) into one section, this amendment is not new policy but rather a mechanical change to the ABP.

The state assures compliance with 42 CFR 440.345 to provide full access to Early Periodic Screening, Diagnosis, and Treatment (EPSDT) services for covered participants by describing the process to access these benefits in Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 1500, Healthy Kids Program.

3. Discussion took place on February 23, 2021 regarding the proposed Amendments to the State Plan for Medicaid Services and solicitation of public comments. As a result, State Plan Amendment (SPA) to Attachment 3.1-A was approved to add in MAT services.

Subject: State Plan Amendment (SPA) to Attachment 3.1-A

This proposed change affects all Medicaid-enrolled providers delivering MAT services for OUD. Those provider types include, but are not limited to: Physician, M.D., Osteopath, D.O., (PT 20), Advance Practice Registered Nurse, (PT 24), Nurse Midwife, (PT 74), Physician's Assistant, (PT 77), Methadone Clinic, (PT 17 Specialty 171), and Substance Abuse Agency Model (SAAM) (PT 17 Specialty 215).

The effective date of change is October 1, 2020.

A Public Hearing has already taken place on June 23, 2020 for the addition of the Medication Assisted Treatment Medicaid Service Manual 3800 policy with the effective date of June 24, 2020.

Nevada Medicaid is unaware of any financial impact to other entities or local government due to the adjustments previously heard at public hearing, other than as stated above.
