2. DHCFP – Updates

- a. <u>ABA State Plan Amendments (SPA) –</u> The policy and rates SPAs are waiting approval from Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). As a reminder it is important to bill for services and receive the denial so that services are billed timely. As soon as CMS approves the SPAs a web announcement will be issued with the information on a recycle.
- b. <u>ABA Policy Effective Date –</u> Services are effective January 1, 2016. All services with the exception of assessments and re-assessments require a prior authorization. ABA policy can be found in <u>Medicaid Services Manual Chapter1500</u>.

3. DHCFP – Surveillance Utilization Review Section (SURS) – Updates

a. <u>SURS overview</u> – DHCFP apologizes, but do to a scheduling conflict SURS was not available. SURS will present an overview at the next meeting.

4. HPE – Updates

- a. <u>Prior Authorization (PA) process PA's should be submitted using forms FA 11-E, along</u> with the FA 11-F diagnosis certification. The PA process is going well, however this is an ongoing evaluation process. Based on the evaluation there will be future revisions to the PA form.
