  - ii. Individualized Treatment Plan (Public Workshop TBA) Alexis provided an overview of streamlining the process concerning the treatment plan by combining the current two plans into one individualized treatment noting the documentation that will be revised for providers to abide by.

### **3. DHCFP- Surveillance Utilization Review (SUR) – Case Management Review**

The SUR program protects the integrity of Nevada Medicaid from fraud and abuse. The program guards against fraud and abuse by providers. It identifies aberrant billing practices, sanctions those who have abused the Medicaid program, recovers overpayments, and assists in criminal investigations when appropriate. SURS can also recommend training or education of billing methodology if appropriate.
