  - Update on the National Governors Association (NGA) Resources for the Early Advancement of Child Health (REACH) program.
  - The Rehabilitation Plan Work Shop that was held on May 9, 2016. This
    revision addressed the rehabilitation plan and updating the documentation
    required. DHCFP Public Notices
  - Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) there are four prospective Bridge Counseling, New Frontier, Vitality and Westcare. CCBHC-Main
  - Psychological Interns are pending a CMS decision to be allowed to be enrolled as A QMHP.
  - Revision to MSM Chapter 400 to address Clinical supervision within policy the removal of interns to be allowed to act as Clinical Supervisor.

Behavioral Health Providers BHCN QA Program Policy Review Review of program requirements for BHCN QA Policy which went into effect 5/1/16 Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 400 (all new revisions to the BHCN are written in red) BHCN Providers; requirement to submit a Quality Assurance (QA) Program BHCN - HPE Billing Manual (starts on page 6) and HPE Announcement 1134 HPE Announcement 1134. Crystal Johnson highlighted the following information:
  - Policy went into effect 5/1/16, please make sure you are referencing current policy and the HPE Billing Manual for further information.
  - Use policy as outline for submission. More is not better, please only submit the documentation required under MSM 403.2.B.6

- a. Ismael Lopez-Ferratt, MBA NV Medicaid Provider Field Services
  Behavioral Health HPE Reminder for Providers: HPE Announcement 1191
  - The federal regulation at 42 CFR 455.414 requires that state Medicaid agencies revalidate the enrollment of all providers, regardless of provider types, at least every five (5) years, with the exception of DMEPOS suppliers which will remain at every three (3) years per 42 CFR 424.57. In order to comply with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requirement for the revalidation process to be completed by September 24, 2016, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) has set a deadline of August 31, 2016.   - Psychosocial Rehabilitation (PSR) Services 403.6G <u>Medicaid Services</u>
     <u>Manual Chapter 400</u> page 41 Service Limitations: All PSR services
     require prior authorization by Medicaid's QIO-Like vendor. Prior
     authorizations <u>may not exceed 90-day intervals</u>. PSR services are based
     on daily maximums. Individual Therapy -MSM Ch. 400, 403.4C3. page 17
