
- -- A total of 130 children were in Out-of-State RTC placement during the month of March 2021.



Out-of-State RTC Child Patients by Provider States March 2021



Count of Out-of-State Residential Treatment Center Child Patients March 2020 - March 2021



Average Net Payment per RTC Child Patient by Provider State Category March 2020 - March 2021







All information is provided in Incurred Mode (by the date of when services were provided). The Nevada Medicaid Fee for Service (FFS) Data Warehouse (DSS) has a three-month block on the most recent months to ensure there is near to 100% processing of all FFS claims. Out-of-State providers have 12 months to submit claims (in-state providers have six months).

The DHCFP data warehouse is comprised of claims data submitted by over 35,000 Medicaid providers from within Nevada and across the country. While DHCFP staff conscientiously make their best efforts to validate this data through continuous provider education and the use of a highly experienced audit staff, the Division heavily relies on its providers to submit accurate and complete information on our Medicaid patients. It should therefore be understood by the users of DHCFP reports on disease morbidity and patient health that the data source for these reports is based solely on patient claims and may not be a complete and comprehensive health record.
