Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The DHCFP is proposing revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 2800 – School Based Child Health Services to align with federal guidance on the "free care" policy reversal. The changes allow school districts to bill Medicaid for health services provided to Medicaid eligible children delivered in the school setting. Reimbursement was previously limited to services defined in a child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
