Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The DHCFP is proposing revisions to the Medicaid State Plan 3.1-F for Managed Care to revise the Managed Care Organization (MCO) auto-assignment algorithm. The auto-assignment algorithm distributes newly approved Medicaid and Nevada Check Up recipients and families among the MCO vendors. The proposed changes include identifying performance-based quality metrics to be used as a component of the auto-assignment algorithm. There are no changes to current policy for American Indians/Alaska Natives (AI/AN) exemption from mandatory MCO enrollment.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Government.
