Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The DHCFP is proposing revisions to the State Plan, Attachment 4.19-B, Page 3 and Page 3 (Continued) for Prescribed Drugs. The State has elected to utilize selective contracting in order to deliver optimal therapy management with sufficient utilization controls for specialty pharmacy drugs used in the treatment of Hemophilia, Hepatitis C and Intravenous Immunoglobulin within the Fee-for-Service program. The DHCFP has established a new payment algorithm for these specific drugs. Further, the DHCFP has created a professional service contract in which the vendor provides clinical and customer service support to recipients and ordering providers.

The effective date of these changes is January 1, 2021.

There is no fiscal impact anticipated to tribal government.
