Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

This is a revision to the previously distributed July 16, 2021 tribal notification letter as we listed the incorrect Assembly Bill. DHCFP is proposing a State Plan Amendment in Attachment 3.1 – A and an update to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 600 – Physician Services, as a result of the passage of Assembly Bill 191 and Senate Bill 420 during the 81st (2021) Legislative session. This will include a new Provider Type (PT) and policy language for community health worker services under the supervision of a physician, physician assistant or advanced practice registered nurse. Community health workers are certified health educators who advocate, integrate and coordinate services across the continuum of health for the prevention and management of chronic disease.

There is no anticipated financial impact on the Tribal Governments.
