Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

DHCFP is proposing updates to the policy under the Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) program, Medicaid Service Manual (MSM) 1500, section 1503.3A.3. The proposed change is to allow for Medicaid to pay for a recipient sick visit on the same date of service as a well check visit from the same provider. The EPSDT program is a federal benefit as defined under the Social Security Act (SSA) 1905(a) and (r). The Nevada EPSDT program includes services such as: Periodic Screenings, Inter-periodic Screenings, Comprehensive Screening Examinations, Diagnostic Services, and Treatment. These services fall under a well check visit.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Government.
