Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

DHCFP is proposing a State Plan Amendment to attachment 3.1-A and Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 600 – Physician Services to reflect the intent of Senate Bill (SB) 190 and SB325 passed during the 81st (2021) Nevada Legislative Session. The amendment will create a new provider type for pharmacists, allowing a pharmacist to bill for the dispensing of self-administered hormonal contraceptives to any patient, and the prescribing, dispensing, and administration of drugs to prevent the acquisition of human immunodeficiency virus (HIV), as well, as perform certain laboratory tests.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact on the Tribal Governments.
