**Dear Tribal Members:** 

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

As originally communicated on August 28, 2020, the DHCFP seeks to waive freedom of choice for specific specialty pharmacy drugs per Social Security Act Section 1902(a)(23) Freedom of Choice via a 1915(b)(4) waiver request. The State has elected to utilize selective contracting to deliver optimal therapy management and utilization controls for Hemophilia, Hepatitis C and Intravenous Immunoglobulin (IVIG) specialty pharmacy drugs within the Nevada Medicaid Fee-for-Service (FFS) program. Additionally, the DHCFP has established a new payment algorithm for these specific drugs and a professional service contract with Optum Specialty Pharmacy® to provide clinical and customer service support to recipients and ordering providers.

There is no fiscal impact anticipated to tribal government.
