Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy (revising State Plan sections 4.19A and 4.19B):

The state is seeking an amendment to State Plan sections 4.19A and 4.19B to establish an additional supplemental payment program for private hospitals in the state of Nevada to increase access to services for Medicaid recipients. These payments would be effective as of July 1, 2023, pending federal approval and apply to both inpatient and outpatient services.
