Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions are being made to the State Plan, Attachment 3.1-A Page 5b #6 and Attachment 3.1-A Page 5c #9 for Prescribed Drugs:

- The maximum quantity of medication per prescription for maintenance medications as a 100-day (3 month) supply, and the maximum quantity of medication for contraceptives as a 12-month supply.

Effective date is July 1, 2017.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.


A change in annual aggregate expenditure cannot be determined at this time.
