Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM), Chapter 1200, Section 1203, are being proposed to reflect the changes in the approved State Plan Amendment, Attachment 3.1-A, Page 5b #6 and Attachment 3.1-A, Page 5c #9 for Prescribed Drugs. The proposed revision will increase the required quantity of medication per prescription for maintenance medications to a 100-day (three-month) supply, and will allow for up to a 12-month supply of a drug for contraception to be dispensed.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
