Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The Waiver for Intellectual Disabilities and Related Conditions (ID) will expire on September 30, 2018. The State is working on the renewal of this waiver, which must be submitted to the Centers for Medicaid Services (CMS) no later than June 30, 2018. Services under this waiver will remain the same, however, there is a new focus on person-centered planning, integrated community involvement, new CMS rules for settings in which the Home and Community Based Services are provided, optimizing individuals' initiative and choice.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact.
