Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 3000, Section 3003.1– Health Services are being proposed to allow eligible Tribal 638 or Tribal Organization 638 outpatient health clinics to enroll as Tribal 638 FQHCs. This service model will promote greater access to specialty and related services outside of the four walls of the tribal clinics for Medicaid eligible American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) recipients.

It is anticipated that this will have a positive impact on Tribal Governments.
