Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions to the State Plan Amendment, Attachment 4.19-B, Page 7a are being proposed to allow eligible Tribal 638 or Tribal Organization 638 outpatient health clinics to enroll as Tribal 638 FQHCs. This service model will promote greater access to specialty and related services outside of the four walls of the tribal clinics for Medicaid eligible American Indian/Alaska Native (AI/AN) recipients

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the tribal governments.
