Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

With the passage of AB 305 which allows for the practice of Community Paramedicine in the state of Nevada, the DHCFP is adopting a Community Paramedicine Policy for its recipients. The DHCFP is proposing to submit a State Plan Amendment (SPA) for the coverage of Community Paramedicine under the coverage authority of Physician Services. The DHCFP will be holding Community Paramedicine workshops on February 19<sup>th</sup> and March 23<sup>rd</sup> to elicit public comment regarding the development of medical coverage criteria and provider qualifications.

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the tribes as this will be an expansion of services and provider qualifications.

We would appreciate a reply within 30 days from the date of this letter. If we do not hear from you within this time, we will consider this an indication that no consultation is requested.
