In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy.

The proposed changes to the Medicaid Service Manual Chapter 400, Mental Health and Alcohol/Substance Abuse Services will be clarifying language to promote the importance of the System of Care core philosophy and approach of family driven, community based and culturally and linguistically competent services. Ensuring that recipients will receive individualized comprehensive health services that promote collaboration between providers and utilize evidence-based practices and continue to be family driven community-based services.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact with the updates to this policy. The proposed revisions are further clarifying the policy.
