Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

- Revising provider qualifications for Neurotherapy and Biofeedback covered services under Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 400.
- Revising inpatient detoxification and treatment days for recipients age 21 years and older to comply with the Mental Health Parity and Addiction Equity Act.
- Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 400 Attachment C regarding prior and post authorization of services allowed under the Substance Abuse Agency Model.
- Align Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 400 provider qualifications with Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 100 provider qualifications.

The DHCFP does not foresee any fiscal impact to the tribes.
