Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy.

A Behaviorally Complex Rate (BCR) is being established with the intention providing incentive to in-state providers to provide care, rather than out-of-state care for Nevada Medicaid recipients with medically-based behavior disorders resulting in the Medicaid recipient posing a danger to self and/or others.

The BCR may be approved for those recipients exhibiting extreme, unpredictable aggression; recipients who have been treated for their severe medically-based behavior disorder or other medical conditions across multiple medical, institutional and/or correctional environments with little or no success; or recipients exhibiting behaviors extremely disruptive or dangerous to themselves, other recipients or Nursing Facility staff.

Currently, patients exhibiting complex behaviors are placed in out-of-state facilities because no in-state facilities are available. It is anticipated that the tiered rate will promote in-state facilities to provide services for these individuals in addition to standardizing rates.
