In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy.

The proposed policy change to MSM Chapter 2500 will allow qualified providers who are employees or contractors of the State to provide Targeted Case Management (TCM) services to the Seriously Mentally Ill (SMI) population. This will be done in accordance with State Plan section 1915(g). This proposed change is not anticipated to have a fiscal impact to the Nevada Tribes.
