Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

With the passage of AB 305 which allows for the practice of Community Paramedicine in the state of Nevada, the DHCFP is adopting a Community Paramedicine Policy for its recipients. The DHCFP is proposing to include Community Paramedicine under the coverage authority of Medicaid Services Manual, Chapter 600, Physician Services, Section 604.

There is an anticipated positive fiscal impact to the tribes as this will be an expansion of services and provider qualifications.
