Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Current Nevada Check Up (NCU) policy prohibits NCU enrollment for children with access to the Public Employee Benefit Program (PEBP). This policy has been reviewed and it has been determined that children with access to PEBP, who fall within the income guidelines and eligibility criteria for NCU, may qualify for and be enrolled in the NCU program. The Nevada State Plan (SPA) and Medical Assistance Manual (MAM) will be updated to reflect this policy change.

We would appreciate a reply within 30 days from the date of this letter. If we do not receive a response from you within this timeframe, we will consider that as an indication no consultation is requested.
