Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan:

S25 Eligibility Groups – Mandatory Coverage Parents and Other Caretaker Relatives

- Removed the first option under 'Parents and Other Caretaker Relatives' regarding the requirement for the child(ren) to be enrolled in school full-time. This will help with case processing and reduce the need to request additional verifications.
- On Page 3, corrected the 'Income standard chosen' from minimum to maximum.

There is no fiscal impact.
