Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy.

The Waiver for the Frail Elderly will expire on June 30, 2015. The state is currently working on the renewal of this waiver which must be submitted to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) no later than March 31, 2015. Services under this waiver will remain the same, however, the State will review the methodology of how waiver providers are paid as the renewal will span a five year period from July 1, 2015 through June 20, 2020.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact.
