In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The DHCFP is proposing revisions to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan, Alternative Benefit Plan, Section 5, Partial Hospitalization, Behavioral Health/Substance Abuse (BH/SA) to allow for the transfer of State Plan authority for Partial Hospitalization Services (PHP) and Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP). This transition in authority changes the PHP and IOP service authority from a demonstration waiver to a permanent service in the Nevada Medicaid State Plan.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
