In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 1200, Appendix A, are being proposed to reflect recommendations approved on January 24, 2019 by the Drug Use Review (DUR) Board. The proposed changes include the addition of prior authorization criteria for short acting beta agonists, revised criteria for compounded medications and new criteria for oral oncology medications, Epidiolex® and pulmonary arterial hypertension agents.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
