Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions to Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) Chapter 1200, - Prescribed Drugs, Appendix A are being proposed to relocate the current policy on External Ambulatory Infusion Pump, Insulin and Supplies coverage policy located in Appendix B of the MSM Chapter 1300 - DME Disposable Supplies and Supplements to MSM Chapter 1200. The policy will also contain revisions and will add coverage for Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) Systems. Lastly, the DHCFP is proposing coverage expansion of diabetic supplies to include all ages based on Federal Drug Administration (FDA) indications.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact on the Tribal Governments.
