Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions are being proposed to the Nevada State Plan, Section 4.b.1, Page 228, School Based Child Health Services (SBCHS). The proposed change will align the State Plan with the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services' (CMS') guidance on the reversal of their opinion on the "free care" rule which prohibited schools from billing Medicaid for services that were provided free to any child in a school district. The expansion of services under SBCHS will allow local school districts to bill for Behavioral Health and Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA) in addition to the services they currently bill for.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
