In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

Revisions are being proposed to the Nevada State Plan Amendment (SPA) to move the rate methodology for Partial Hospitalization Services (PHP) and the Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) from Home and Community Based Waivers, Attachment 4.19-B, pages 17-18a to the Non-Residential Mental Health Services, Attachment 4.19-B, pages j-k. There are no proposed changes for the rate methodology for IOP/PHP.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
