Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The DHCFP is proposing revisions to the Nevada Medicaid State Plan, Section 3.1-G, Pages 32, 32A and 32B and Section 3.1-G - Page 1, to allow for the transfer of State Plan authority for Partial Hospitalization Services (PHP) and Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP). The authority for these services will be in the Nevada Medicaid State Plan Section 3.1-A, in the following: Page 1a - Sections 2.a and 2.c, and Page 6b - Sections 11 and 12. This transition in authority changes the PHP and IOP service authority from a demonstration waiver to a permanent service in the Nevada Medicaid State Plan.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
