Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy:

The proposed change to the policy is to align with the intent of Senate Bill (SB)162 from the 2017 Legislative Session that revises the provisions relating to psychological assistants, psychological interns and psychological trainees. SB162 allows for assistants, interns and trainees to render services under the supervision of a designated licensed Psychological Supervisor as identified in Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) and Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 641. This will expand the provider qualifications and allow these three qualifications to enroll independently.

Additionally, the proposed policy change will allow assistants, interns and trainees to enroll under the Psychologist Provider Type (PT) 26 and will remove them from under the current structure of the Behavioral Health Community Network (BHCN) PT 14. This will allow for appropriate supervision as identified through the Board of Psychological Examiners.

There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Tribal Governments.
