In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change related to the Preferred Drug List for pharmacy services.

The 26<sup>th</sup> Special Session revised provisions of Nevada Revised Statute 422, Senate Bill 4, governing the list of preferred prescription drugs to be used in the Nevada Medicaid program. The new regulation allows for particular drugs classes to be added to the preferred drug list, implement grandfathering procedures for particular drugs, and modify the Preferred Drug List Exception criteria.
