In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy regarding non-emergency transportation services for Nevada Check Up (NCU) recipients effective June 1st, 2010.

Updates are being proposed to Medicaid Services Manual, Chapter 1900 to correct the improper designation of the non-emergency transportation broker as a prepaid ambulatory health plan (PAHP). Removing the PAHP designation allows DHCFP more flexibility in determining rates to the broker.
