Dear Sirs:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in Medicaid Services Manual Chapter 3400- Telehealth Services. DCHFP plans to expand the covered telehealth services to include family and group psychotherapy. In addition DHCFP will add: "A person who is employed and determined by a state mental health agency to meet established class specification qualifications of a Mental Health Counselor or clinical social worker" as medical/behavioral health providers who may bill for covered telehealth services at a distant site.

It is anticipated that the proposed expansion of services may have potential direct impact to Indian Health Programs and/or tribal governments.
