Dear Tribal Members:

In accordance with established consultation guidelines, the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) is notifying Nevada tribes of the following proposed change in policy.

Chapter 400 of the Medicaid Services Manual (MSM) is the Medical Coverage Policies and Procedures for Mental Health and Alcohol/Substance Abuse Services. This chapter outlines the covered benefits and service limitations for the behavioral health providers and various health care providers to understand allowable covered and non-covered services.

The proposed revisions to the MSM chapter 400 were made to clarify specific requirements as well as the coverage and limitations of day treatment services. The policy has been expanded to more clearly break out specific age groups and the criteria for services and non-covered services. The proposed policy revision also expands on the provider requirements and program criteria.

Additional proposed revisions to the MSM chapter 400 also include further clarification on the definition of group therapy versus individual therapy. This is will assist in clearing up any confusion on what can be billed as individual therapy or group therapy.

There is no fiscal impact with the updates to this policy. The proposed revisions are clarifying the policy further.
