Dear Sirs:

This is to advise you that the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) intends to submit a state plan amendment to provide for supplemental payments for outpatient services delivered by non-state governmentally owned or operated teaching hospitals. The aggregate of all payments shall not exceed the federal Upper Payment Limit. The provider type affected by this change will be Hospital, Outpatient (12). The local government entity affected by this change will be Clark County, operator of University Medical Center of Southern Nevada.

Our intention is to have a public hearing on the amendment sometime in March and have it become effective for services delivered on or after March 1, 2010.

The DHCFP would like to extend an opportunity for a specific consultation regarding this new policy. If you would like this consultation, please contact Glenda Grafton who will schedule a meeting. We would appreciate a reply whether or not you would like this consultation, however if we do not hear from you within 30 days from the date of this letter we will consider that an indication that no consultation is requested.
