# FUNDING OPPORTUNITY SCHOOL-BASED DENTAL HEALTH PROGRAMS

### Request for Applications

The Nevada Department of Health and Human Services Division of Health Care Financing and Policy released a Request for Applications targeting Nevada's health districts, community and non-profit organizations, FQHCs, community-based clinics, and school-based health centers as well as educational institutions, school districts, and other Nevada licensed entities that are interested in being awarded one-time ARPA funds to support school-based dental sealant programs to improve the oral health of Nevada's schoolage children and youth.

#### **Purpose**

To increase the number of Nevada's school-age children and youth who have dental sealants, through support for school-based sealant programs.

# Why Dental Sealants?

Dental sealants are an evidence-based approach to preventing tooth decay in permanent molar teeth where most cavities occur. Unfortunately, dental sealants are underutilized with less than half of school-age children and youth having at least one sealant. According to the CDC, school sealant programs are an effective means to deliver these effective preventive services.





# **Funding Opportunity**

One-time ARPA funding up to \$70,500 per grantee may be used to purchase portable dental equipment, dental supplies, PPE, consumables including toothbrushes and toothpaste, and translation and printing services.

Applications are due Friday, October 6, 2023, at 5:00pm PST.
