4. For Possible Action: Discussion and proposed adoption of MSM Chapter 4200 – Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC).

MSM Chapter 4200 is being proposed as a new chapter. The DHCFP is proposing a new chapter for the Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) demonstration grant awarded by the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) in collaboration with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). This is a two-year demonstration grant and is designed to create integrated care and coordination of quality care for improved health outcomes for individuals with behavioral health disorders. This chapter will outline the provider qualifications, services and the description and intent of CCBHC delivery model.

Entities Financially Affected: A new Provider Type, PT 17 Specialty 188, has been developed for this two-year demonstration. This will not impact currently existing providers as this will create formal relationships with other providers and community services for an integrated care model.

Financial Impact on Local Government: Unknown at this time.
