Tribal Consultation Action Items

October 14, 2014

Division of Aging and Disability Services (ADSD) – Tina Gerber-Winn

- ADSD provided an update on the Task Force on Alzheimer's Disease, and behavior health placement with out-of-state nursing facilities.
- The Tribal Governments requested assistance with and eligibility question and will follow up with ADSD.

Division of Child and Family Services (DCFS) – Dixie Jeffers

- DCFS is in the process of developing a Tribal Consultation process. ;

Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) – Nova Murray

DWSS provided an update on moving to the State supported exchange using healthcare.gov. Medicaid applications will no longer go through Nevada Health Link. Effective November 10th, 2014 Medicaid electronic applications are entered through ACCESS Nevada or paper applications can be submitted to the local DWSS Office.

- DWSS presented how prescreening will work for Nevada Medicaid eligibility.
- DWSS provided an update on presumptive eligibility
 - The Tribal Government requested to participate in the focus group to discuss the impact on the Tribal Clinics and services.
 - The Tribal Government requested a list of hospitals participating in order to reduce duplication of applications.
- DWSS will have training for community partners
 - The Tribal Government requested participation in the training for community partners.

Silver State Health Insurance Exchange (SSHIX) – Tyler Klimas

- SSHIX provided a presentation on using healthcare.gov, the State supported exchange.
 - The Tribal Government requested to participate in the Certified Application Counselor (CAC) and Navigator training.
- SSHIX will be focusing on consumer advocacy and outreach
 - The Tribal Government requested SSHIX evaluate if the Tribes can sponsor premiums through the Exchange.

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Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP) – Shannon Sprout

- DHCFP provided an update on the Managed Care Organization (MCO)
 - The Tribal Governments requested contact information Health Plan (HPN) of Nevada and Amerigroup. <https://dhcfp.nv.gov/ManagedCare/MCO.htm>
 - The Tribal Government requested the most current list of MCO's. <http://dhcfpintranet/Business%20Lines/vendors.html>
- DHCFP provided a presentation on the State Plan Amendment (SPA) process.
- DHCFP presented the potential 2015 consultation schedule
 - The Tribal Government agreed. The schedule will be posted to the DHCFP's website: [2015 Tribal Consultation Schedule](#)
- As a result of prior consultations and feedback from the Tribes a Draft version of the American Indian and Alaska Native Medicaid and Nevada Check Up Fact Sheet was presented.
 - The Tribal Government had no immediate comments and requested two weeks to review and comment. DHCFP emailed the draft fact sheet for comments. At the completion of this process, the fact sheet will go through clearance before it becomes public.
- DHCFP presented Tribal Notification Letter (TNL) 14-41 MSM 3000 in order to move forward with increasing encounters from three to five.
 - The Tribal Government requested reasoning for the length of time for a resolution from Administration.
 - The Tribal Government requested review of professional groups
 - The Tribal Government requested a copy of the Budget Concept Paper for the increased encounters.
 - In response the DHCFP will provide a copy of the Budget Concept Paper, and agreed to schedule a Tribal Consultation specific to address the encounters and professional groups to include Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services, Indian Health Service, and the Division of Health Care Financing and Policy Administration.
