Division of Health Care Financing and Policy (DHCFP)

- Presentation on Telehealth - Andy Rico and Rebecca Vernon-Ritter
The state is moving forward to align the information in the Policy with the State Plan Amendment.
- Presentation on Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinics (CCBHC) - Alexis Tucey
The plan for demonstration grand is due October 22, 2016. CCBHCs will provide comprehensive services in collaboration with Designated Collaborating Organizations (DCO) when appropriate. Of the nine required services, five may be provided through DCOs. CCBHCs will partner/collaborate with providers and the local community to provide services. The programs must be certified by State Quality Assurance.
 - The Tribal Governments requested the list of the nine required services be sent to them. List was provided.

Division of Welfare and Supportive Services (DWSS) – Sherry Haar

- Update provided on the status of applications processing.

Silver State Health Exchange (SSHIX) - Tiffany Davis

- Update provided on the changes that have recently taken place within SSHIX. Introduced new liaison. The SSHIX is preparing for open enrollment. They will have a kickoff event on November 1, 2016 in Reno/Las Vegas.
 - The Tribal Governments requested information as to how many insurance companies are available.
Tiffany responded last year there were 88,000 enrolled and as of September 30, 2016, there are approximately 78,000 who have an HMO/PPO plan.

Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)

- DHHS presented on Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health Act.

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Division of Child and Family Services (DCFS)

- ICWA Final Rule takes effect on 12/12/16. Department of Interior and Bureau of Indian Affairs are offering free in-person trainings and webinars for all tribal members and state workers. Dates and times are posted on the DOI and BIA website. The final Indian Child Welfare Meeting will be held in November 2016. Waiting to hear back from Western BIA agency to see if they can host an ICWA final rule webinar and the ICW Committee Meeting on the same day.
- Sharon Benson, Senior Deputy Attorney General and Fran presented on ICWA and MOU's between Tribes and DCFS in Battle Mountain last month. Feedback received was positive and a request for more trainings throughout the state was suggested.
- National Indian Child Welfare Association (NICWA) extended an invitation to this liaison to present at their annual conference in April 2017. NICWA is interested in how Nevada creates MOUs and works with Tribes for the benefit of Indian children and families.

Division of Public and Behavior Health (DPBH)

- Presentation on Recruitment and Retention of Health Care Providers.

Aging and Disability Services Division (ADSD)

- Discussion on open enrollment and list of programs available from their division.
